## Sirènes' Good Practices

- Wear clothing suitable for the **weather conditions** (windbreaker, sun cream, hats, etc.)
- **Anticipate the crowds** to be able to park (limited parking spaces in Morgat and Camaret).
- Be present **15 minutes before departure** at the boarding point indicated on your ticket, access to the boat may be refused in the 5 minutes preceding departure.
- **Do not lose your ticket, it cannot be reissued in case of loss.**
- If you are entitled to a discount, present your **proof of reduction** before payment, no discount can be made once the ticket is issued.
- **Book online** to take out cancellation insurance in case of unforeseen events (optional insurance available only online).

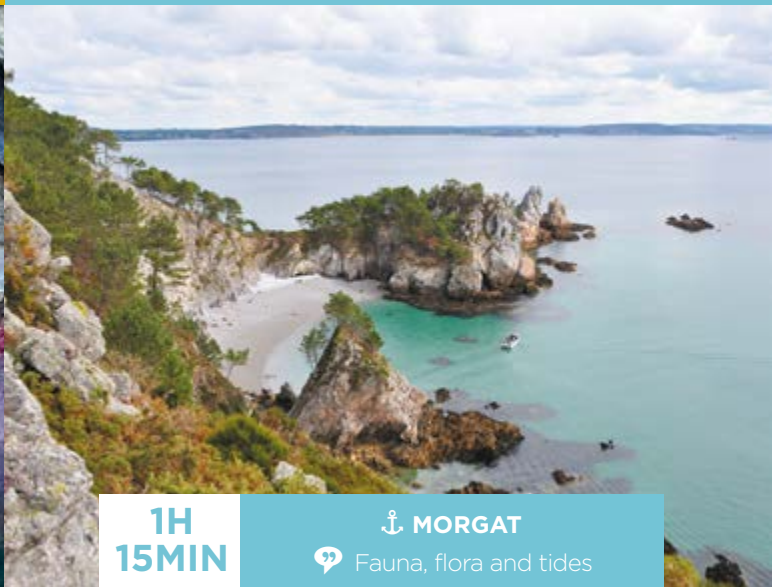

### Embark with our «sailor-guides» for a unique experience, a journey through time.

Sail in the Anse de Morgat to discover a veritable open-air museum, visible on site thanks to the rock outcrops, geological mille-feuilles that have preserved the memory of hundreds of millions of years of history. Renowned for the variety of colours that adorn their internal walls, the sea caves offer sumptuous and original spectacles.

Discover the developments from the beginning of the seaside resort, developed in 1884 by Armand Peugeot and Louis Richard.

### Discover the hidden beauty of the cliffs, wild creeks and pebble beaches, most of which are only accessible by sea.

Sail along the steep cliffs covered with moorland and pine trees, giving the landscape a Mediterranean feel. With our «sailor-guides», you will discover this treasure of preserved biodiversity from the water. You will understand the influence of the tides on the particular way of life of the species present on the foreshore.

And if the sea conditions permit, the crew will show you the unique interior of the Grotte de l'Église (Church Cave), a magnificent curiosity located not far from the Pointe du Dolmen.

### Sail towards Cap de la Chèvre aboard the Sirène V: thrills and breathtaking views guaranteed!

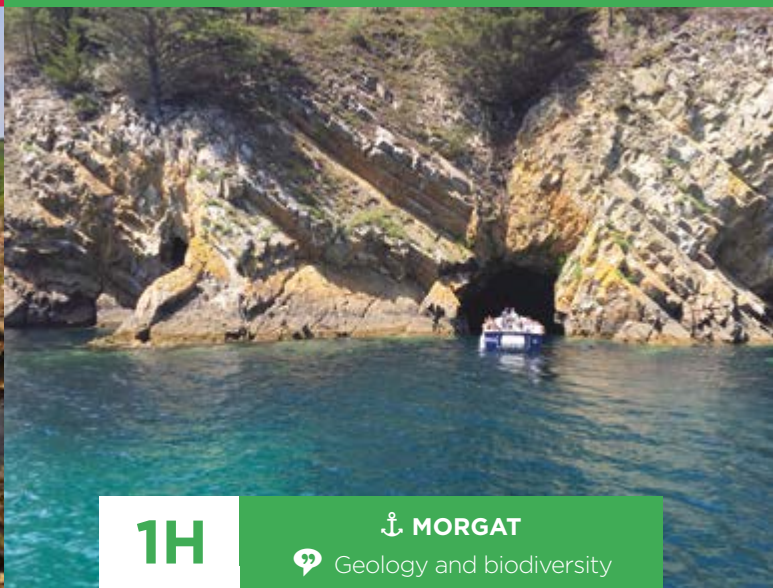

**Come and discover one of the largest but also one of the most beautiful harbours in the world.**

A vast body of water protected from the storms of the Iroise Sea thanks to the Roscanvel peninsula, leaving a narrow passage, 1.8km wide, known as the «Goulet de Brest». For centuries, Brest has had strategic importance, and during the trip you can admire defensive military structures as well as sites steeped in history, such as the Île de Trébéron and the Île des Morts in Roscanvel Bay.

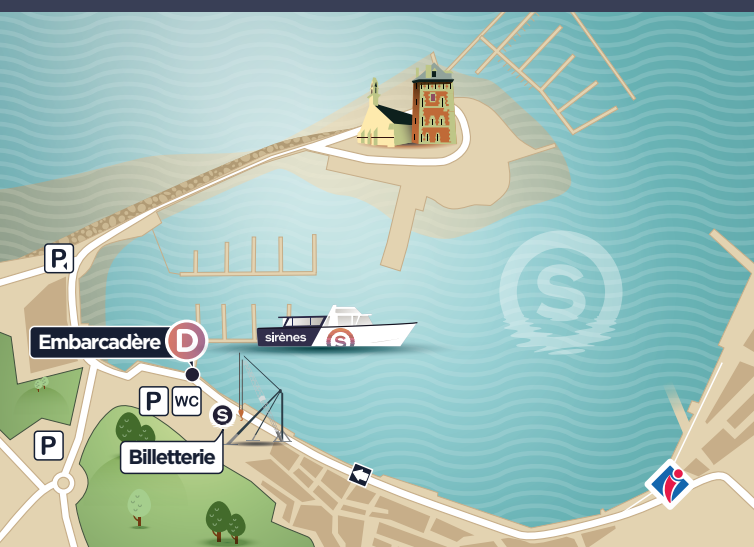
